About Calgary

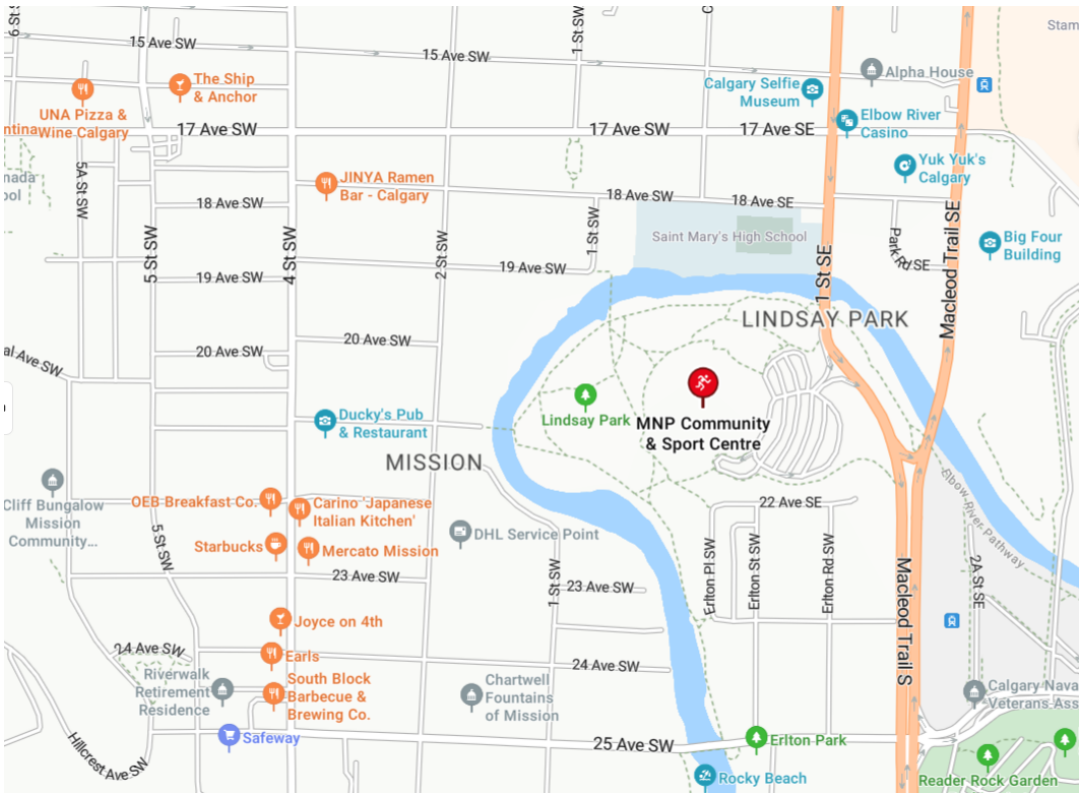

Payment and Cancellation Policy

All fees are payable in CAD, unless otherwise stated. Registration will only be confirmed once full payment has been received.

Cancellation policy:

- Course fee refunds must follow ITF and host organization requirements, including deregistration through ITF Online if applicable.

All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to the organizers. The following cancellation policy applies to IIC registration fees:

Cancellation received on or before August 3, 2027: A 10% cancellation/administration fee will apply. The remaining 90% of eligible registration fees will be refunded.

Cancellation received August 4–26, 2027: A 30% cancellation/administration fee will apply. The remaining 70% of eligible registration fees will be refunded.

Cancellation received August 27–September 3, 2027 A 50% cancellation fee will apply. The remaining 50% of eligible registration fees will be refunded.

No Show: No refund will be provided where a participant does not attend the IIC and has not provided written notice of cancellation.

Exceptional Circumstances: A full or partial refund outside the standard policy may be considered where serious unforeseen or exceptional circumstances occur. Such requests will be considered by the organizers on a case-by-case basis. Supporting documentation may be requested.

Any non-refundable bank, transaction, processing, merchandise, meal, apparel, attraction or third-party costs already incurred or committed may be deducted from an otherwise approved refund.

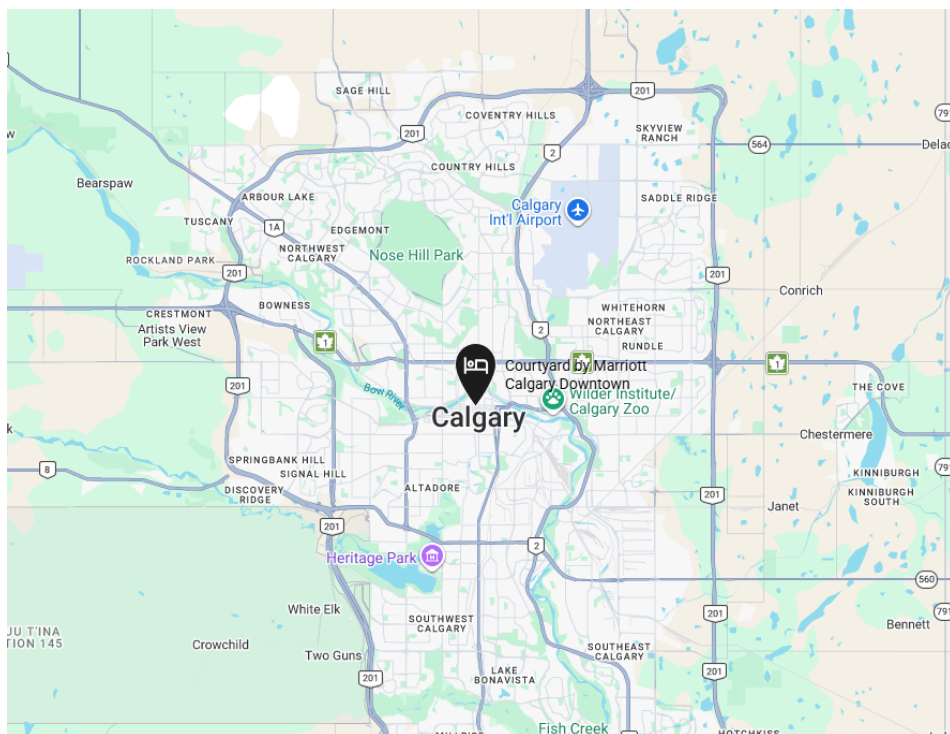

2027 Banff Legacy Tour

Monday, September 6, 2027

Calgary → Banff National Park → Calgary

Following the 2027 International Instructors Course in Calgary, participants are invited to join us for a unique day in the Canadian Rockies celebrating the history, legacy, and spirit of Taekwon-Do.

This special experience will be led by Grand Master Norman and Grand Master Lajeunesse, both of whom were part of the original *Taekwon-Do Legacy* filming in Banff. Participants will have the rare opportunity to train with them, hear their personal stories and memories from the original filming, and experience firsthand some of the locations connected to this important chapter in Taekwon-Do history.

The tour will include a visit to Bow Falls, a recognizable location featured in the original *Taekwon-Do Legacy* footage with General Choi Hong Hi, professional photography with Master Robert Scott, a special outdoor Legacy Training & Stories session led by Grand Master Norman and Grand Master Lajeunesse, and free time to enjoy downtown Banff.

This will be more than a sightseeing tour — it will be an opportunity to walk in the footsteps of Taekwon-Do history, train where part of that legacy was captured, and hear the stories directly from those who were there.

Tentative Schedule

Time	Activity
7:30 AM	Participants begin gathering at the Courtyard by Marriott Calgary Downtown for attendance, tour check-in and bus loading. Participants should arrive dressed appropriately for the weather and have their dobok and training equipment with them.
7:50 AM	Final boarding and participant count.
8:00 AM SHARP	Depart Calgary for Banff National Park.
9:30–9:45 AM	Approximate arrival at Bow Falls. Bus unloading, washroom opportunity and short walk to the photography area.
9:45–11:15 AM	Bow Falls Legacy Photo Experience — professional and group photography at one of the recognizable locations connected to the original <i>Taekwon-Do Legacy</i> footage.
11:15–11:30 AM	Board the coach and travel to Fenlands Meadow.
11:30 AM–1:00 PM	Legacy Training & Stories with Grand Master Norman and Grand Master Lajeunesse — a special outdoor training session accompanied by personal stories, memories and insights from their involvement in the original Legacy filming.
1:00–1:15 PM	Conclude training, Legacy group photograph, pack equipment and transfer to downtown Banff.
1:15–3:30 PM	Lunch on Your Own & Free Time in Banff — explore downtown Banff, enjoy lunch, shop or take in the surrounding mountain scenery.
3:30 PM	All participants return to the designated bus loading area for final attendance.
3:45 PM SHARP	Depart Banff for Calgary.
5:30–6:00 PM	Expected arrival at the Courtyard by Marriott Calgary Downtown.

Schedule and locations are tentative and may be adjusted based on weather, Parks Canada requirements and operational considerations.

Etiquette During the IIC

- All participants must wear a clean and ironed official ITF dobok during training sessions.
- Before each new session, participants must line up to welcome the instructor(s).
- After each session, participants must remain in place until the instructor(s) have left the venue.
- Participants must act in accordance with official ITF protocol.
- Participants standing at ease should assume the appropriate ready stance with hands behind their backs.
- Participants sitting on the floor at ease should remain respectful and attentive.
- Participants wishing to ask a question should stand, assume the appropriate posture, and state their name and country before asking.
- Cell phones should be silenced during training sessions.

Promotional Testing During the IIC

Candidates wishing to test for degree promotion during the IIC must follow all ITF requirements and deadlines.

- Submit thesis, curriculum vitae, and application form through the National or Allied Association to ITF HQ at least three months prior to the promotion date, or as required by the ITF.
- Send notice of intent to the IIC organizers by email at info@aitfc.ca
- Pay any examiner or grading fees as directed.
- Bring required breaking materials, if applicable and approved.
- Confirm all requirements directly with the host committee and ITF before making travel plans.

Photography and Media Policy

Only official photographers or media representatives approved by the organizing committee and ITF Technical Committee may take photos or videos during restricted portions of the course. No photos or videos of the course may be published without appropriate permission.
